Dr. Anna Maria Persiani is Associate Professor, she is head of the Fungal Biodiversity Laboratory of the Department of Environmental Biology at Sapienza University of Rome. She is author of more than 80 papers in international and national peer-reviewed journals and 50 congress presentations. Her research activity deals with soil fungal communities in relation to natural, extreme environment, cultivated, polluted and disturbed terrestrial ecosystems. She has been responsible for research units in National Programs, has participated in many national and International Research Projects, has collaborated with numerous international scientific institutions, and has taken part in several scientific expeditions. She is member of national and international scientific societies. She is involved in editorial services (subject editor, guest editor and referee for international scientific Journals) as well as in evaluation activities. She was thesis supervisor of large number of bachelor and master's degree students. She was research tutor in PhD course in Environmental biology (Joint PhD - XXVII cycle) and currently in the PhD in Environmental and Evolutionary Biology Program (curriculum Botany).
